FM Radio Bible teaching

<u>Each week</u> Frantz is getting on-air to teach the Bible <u>without restrictions</u>. Typically, Manasse FM and Bethanie FM are calling routinely. Others have had mechanical and electrical problems, overheating, flooding or not enough gas for their generators. Remember, Port-de-Paix, Haiti generally has no electrical power system operational.

One FM station is in a gang controlled area south of the city, so Frantz has only been on-air via telephone. Formidable FM recently called again for Frantz and we are grateful. Relax FM has been in discussions with Frantz and we await a decision from them.

We are delighted with the doors God has opened to us. Frantz, yielding his life to serve, and your financial and prayer support make a big statement of faith in God. Thanks to each of you!

"While the earth remains, <u>Seedtime and Harvest</u>, Cold and Heat, Winter and Summer, And Day and Night Shall Not Cease." Genesis 8:22 The <u>President's office</u> and <u>Prime Minister's office</u> in Haiti have now been filled, at least until official elections are held. It is no guarantee of success but there is a hope for less chaos.

Haiti's "President" is a actually a "Transitional Council" with 7 voting members.

That council subsequently selected Garry Conille to fill the Prime Ministers office.

Garry is a Haitian man with a medical background, was previously Haiti's Prime Minister for a few months in 2011 and 2012, and has since worked with UN programs.

The "President" has until February 2026 to turn over their powers to those fairly elected.

UN Troops have been promised and Haiti still awaits their arrival. These troops, once in place, will be tasked with helping Haiti's National Police restore security sufficient for elections to be held. Increased numbers of gangs, guns and total area under control by gangs will likely make this UN deployment a bigger challenge than before.

It's a good time to remember the old gospel song, **City Coming Down**. It reminds us that we are not looking for a city or country or government that is being built up.

We look for a city, an eternal city, that is coming down, from heaven.

The Ruler of that eternal city is Jesus and we know he is at work. Jesus himself said that he kept his eyes on the Father and did only what he saw his Father doing (John 5:19).

We would do well to follow that advice.

We keep an eye on Haiti's politics simply to be aware of changes in conditions or rules for working in Haiti. However, we know who is in charge.
