Sound boring? Think again. Seedtime has been very successful in generating excitement with Bible reading in Haiti for years. When we hit a high note with that subject we have Bible reading calendars to give students that are gladly received.

In our Bible studies students read something they've not seen before, something directly relevant to their life situation today. It drives their desire to read more. However, we have been concerned that our Bible reading calendar is not well suited for Haiti. So we decided to fix that.

Revision 2.0 is finished and we're very happy with it. The font is doubled. The format is simplified and doesn't depend on what month it is or whether or not it is morning or evening. Each simplification is viewed as an increased chance of their getting more reading done. This is a New Testament version and we plan to prepare an Old Testament version for those who desire it.

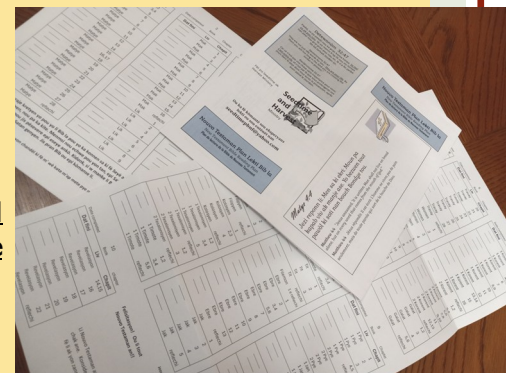
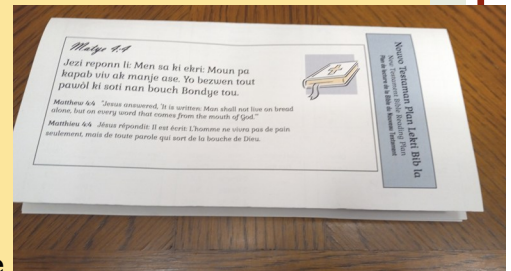
Now, let us tell you about how Revision 2.0 got funded.

We liken it to the story of the Widow and Oil from 2 Kings chapter 4. Elisha asked the poor widow, despite her poverty, what do you have in your house? She had just one small jar of oil. The Prophet quickly concluded good, we'll begin with that. Today, folks would say her supply was inadequate for the task, then go take up an offering. Not so with the widow and not so with us.

Longtime Seedtime Friend, Mulvane Christian church, accepted for us to use their printer and toner, if we could bring our own paper. Down the street Crosswinds Community church had a pile of the right size paper, sitting neglected in their basement. It was considered just like the small jar of oil, just a little bit of nothing. But God wants to tell the widow and tell us today that he is nearby, and when fully dedicated to him, even the smallest things can yield big gains.

Yes, we put those parts together and are currently cutting, folding and preparing to ship hundreds of New Testament Bible Reading Plans!

Now, Frantz can continue to hand them out, new and improved, striking while the iron is hot.
